

2018 Antique Car Registration

Dear Prospective Participant:

The Canfield 4th of July Parade will take place on Wednesday, July 4, 2018.

All vehicle entries must be of 1985 vintage or older for participation in the Antique Auto Division for the 2018 Canfield Fourth of July Parade. Participant assumes any and all risk during participation in the Canfield Fourth of July Parade event. Ensure that your entered vehicle(s) is properly insured in accordance with Ohio law. Thank you for your participation!

LINE-UP: Parade participants are encouraged to begin lining up at 8:30 AM to give the committee time to number your car. You must be at the assigned street final positions no later than 9:30 AM. A numbered paper plate will be placed on your headlight so your auto will be announced as you pass the reviewing stand at the Village Green. The Parade leaves promptly at 10:10 AM

- YOUR ASSIGNED STREET FOR PARADE ASSEMBLY IS: GREEN DRIVE.
(starters will direct you to location)

ENTER the Fairgrounds through GATE #3 off of Fairground Blvd. or through GATE #8 on Rt. 46 just south of Gate 5 across from Mill Creek Metro Parks' McMahon Hall.

EXIT the Fairgrounds through GATE#5 Located on State Rt.46 across from the State Highway Patrol. DO NOT enter through this gate.

Parade travels North on Rt. 46 (South Broad) from Gate #5 around the Village Green and west on Rt. 62 (Lisbon Street) to the Canfield Middle School parking.

Restrooms: At the south end of the Grandstand, Gate #5 near the pumpkin barn, and behind the fair office.

PARADE RULES & PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES:

- Distribution of items other than candy is NOT permitted. No flyers, coupons, etc.
- Candy throwing from a vehicle, unit, or float is NOT permitted. This is a safety and liability issue. Violators will be expelled from the parade route by the Canfield Police Department. In addition, violators will be excluded from future parades.
- To distribute candy you must have designated candy-walkers. Candy-walkers walk with the unit on the white lines at the side of the street. This is an important child safety issue. Candy-walkers must keep pace with their unit.
- Bullhorns are NOT permitted. Sound systems must be pre-approved by the Committee.

ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST CONTINUE TO MOVE FORWARD AND MAY NOT EXIT THEIR VEHICLES UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES

In the past the Parade has experienced stoppages and gaps. In order to prevent this, all participants are asked to continue moving along the parade route. Stopping the parade progression will NOT be tolerated by the Parade Committee. The Committee and the Canfield Police Department will be monitoring the progression of the parade to assure that entrants are not in violation of this rule.

- No water-propelling devices are permitted. (Examples include super-soakers, squirt guns and water balloons.)

FOR PROFIT - BUSINESS ENTRANTS:

- Your participation must be pre-approved by the 4th of July Committee. A minimum \$50 contribution, payable to the Canfield Fourth of July Committee, IS REQUIRED.
- No advertising brochures, flyers, or coupons may be distributed.
